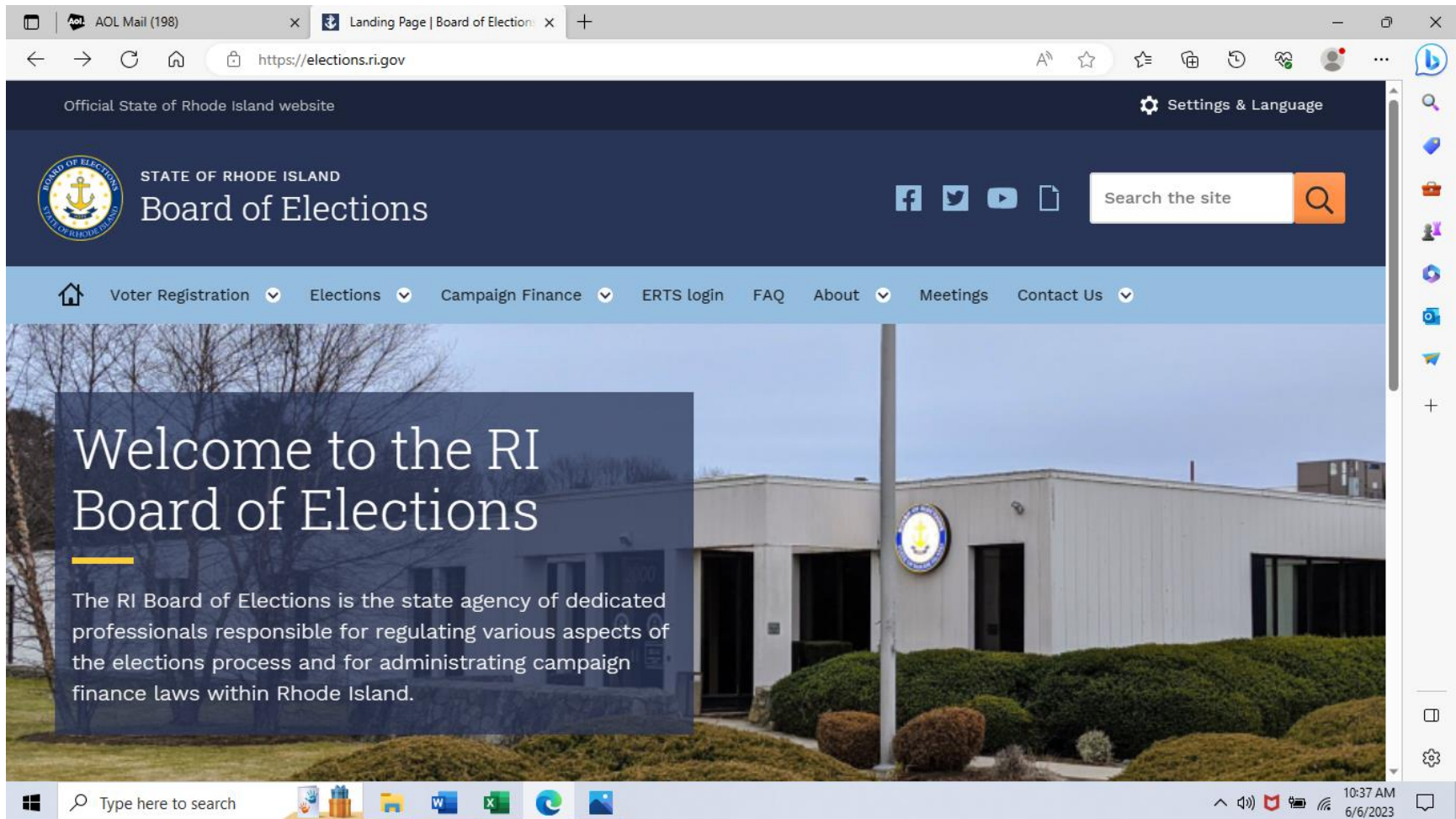


**In order to cast a ballot in the September 5, 2023 Democrat Primary

Ensure you are Eligible to Vote in the 2023 Congressional District 1 Special Election on November 7, 2023?

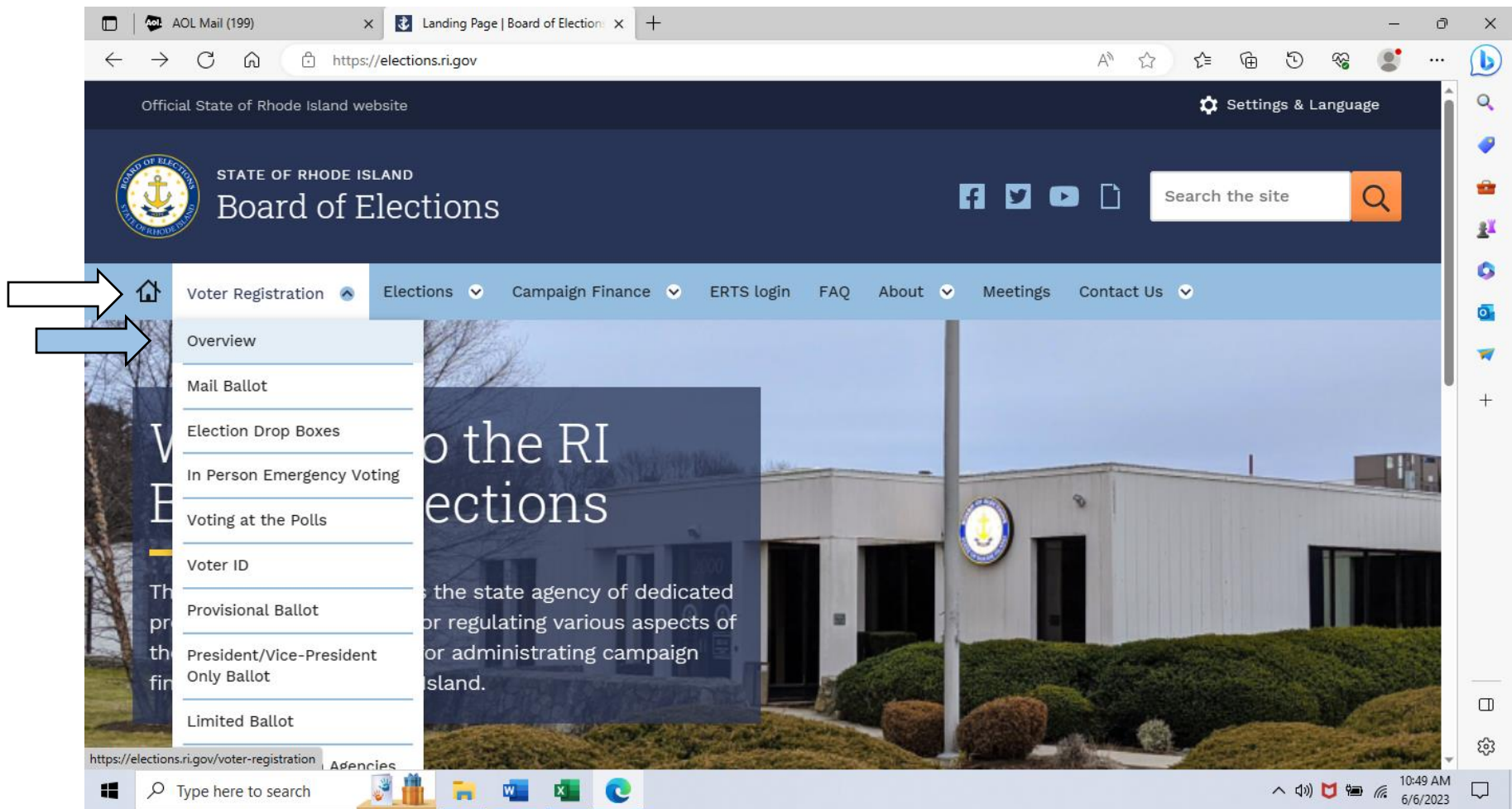
