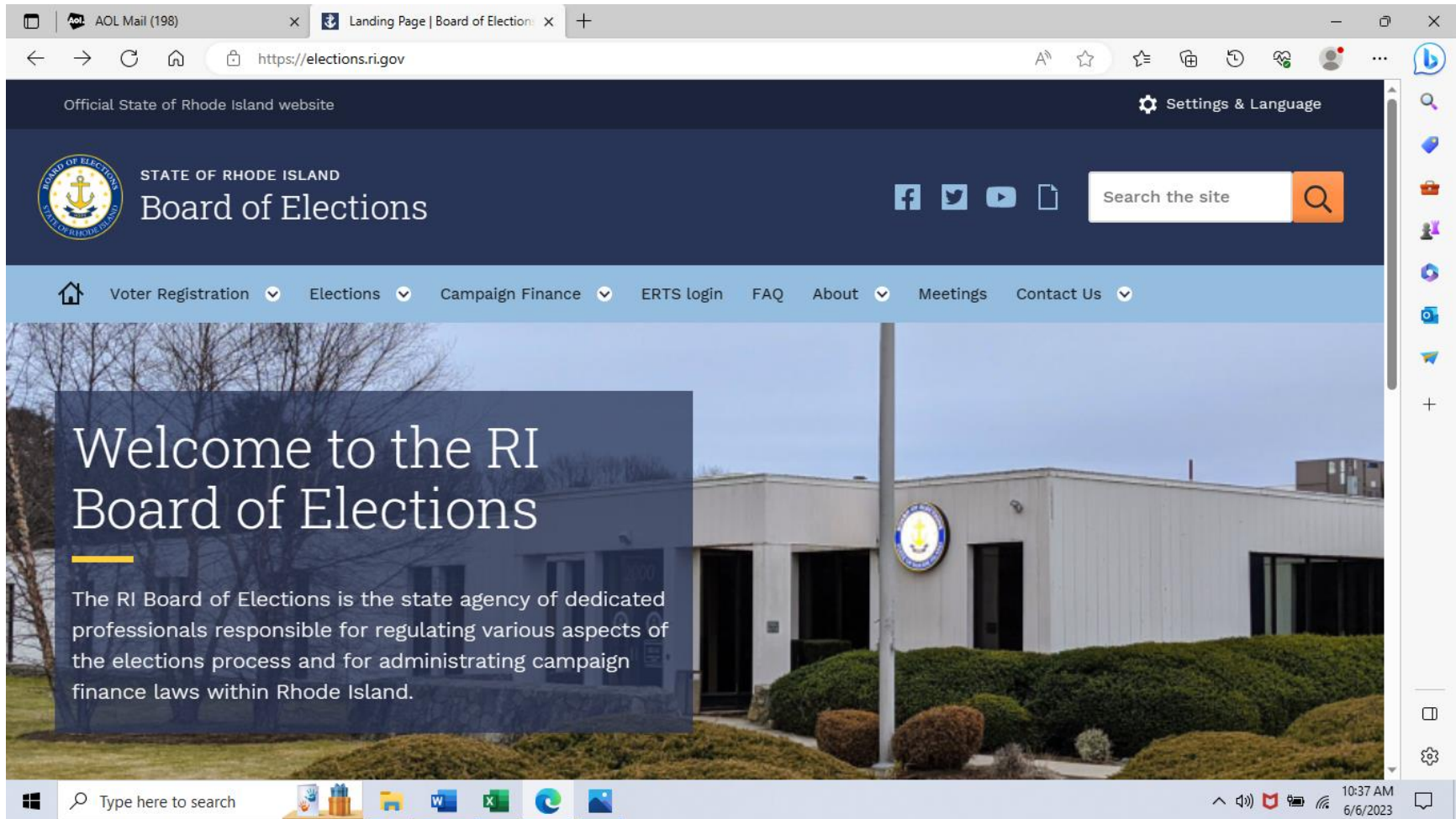
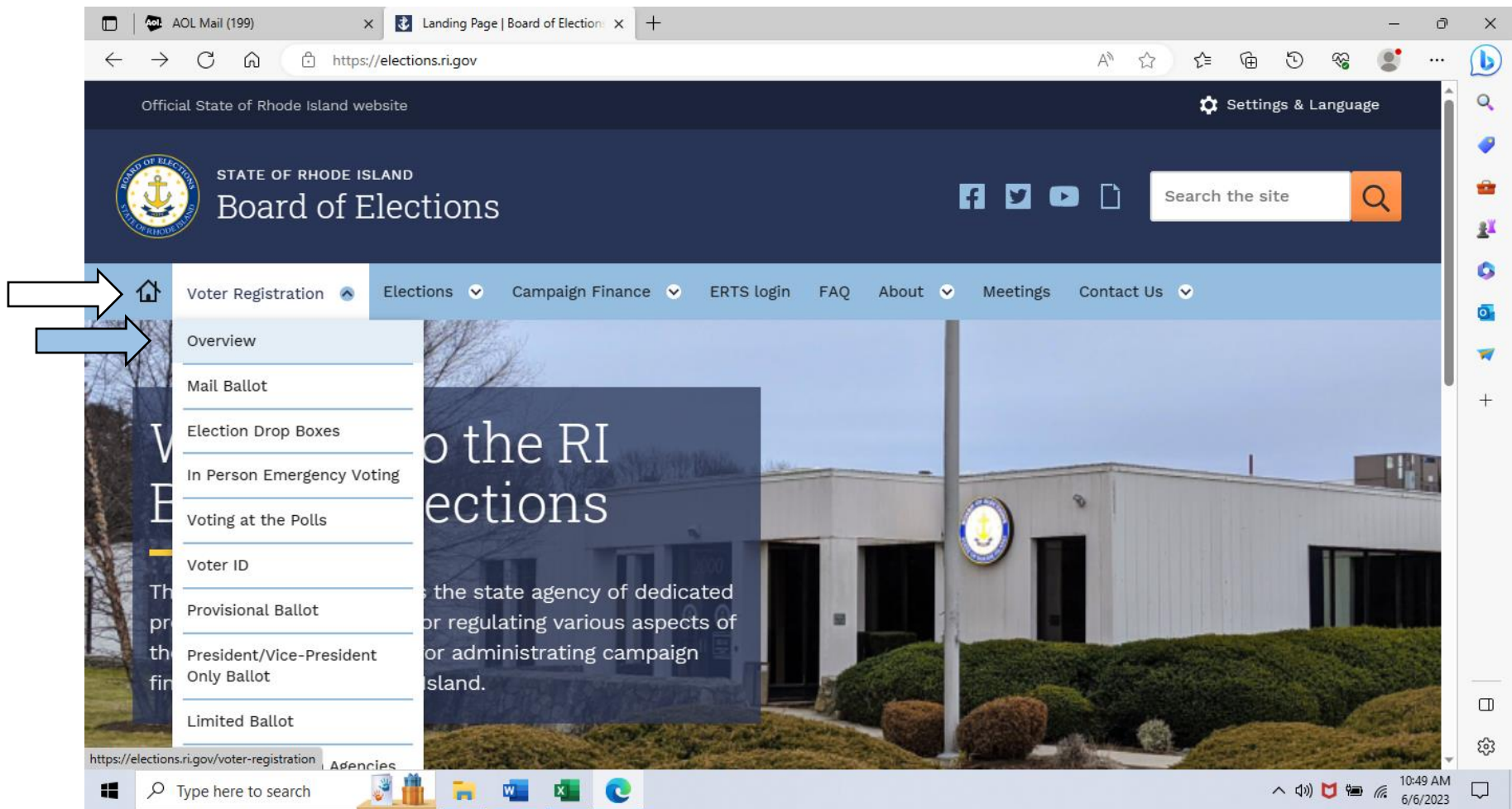


**In order to cast a ballot in the September 5, 2023 Democrat Primary

- Your Rhode Island DMV issued driver's license or State ID number
- Your name as it appears on your Rhode Island driver's license or State ID card
- Your date of birth

Alternatively, you may complete the form without your driver's license or State ID number for paper submission.

I am a U.S. Citizen and resident of Rhode Island.

I am at least 16 years of age (you must be at least 18 years of age to vote).

I am not incarcerated in a correctional facility upon a felony conviction.

I am not presently judged "mentally incompetent" to vote by a court of law.
